In order to list on eBay to benefit our tall ships, you'll need to select the option to "donate a percentage." When you do so, the eBay Giving Works ribbon will appear and you'll select an organization to benefit from your listing. To list correctly:

1. Go to eBay's site: <http://www.ebay.com/>.
2. Click the 'Sell' tab in the upper right-hand corner of the eBay homepage. Next select the blue "start selling" box.
3. Begin the listing process. If you are given the option, please select "more listing choices." Otherwise you will be taken to the Sell Your Item form. It is important to use the form that includes all listing options.
4. Continue the listing process. Once you get to the "Choose how you'd like to sell your item" section, you will see the field to "donate a percentage of sale."
5. You may need to conduct a search for "Grays Harbor Historical Seaport Authority" and add it to your list of charities.
6. Select "Grays Harbor Historical Seaport Authority" and a 10 to 100% donation.
