Director's Message: 2017 Gratitude Report

Friends, your support made 2017 a year of positive change at the Historical Seaport. This is the year you jump-started Project Overhaul to refresh Hawaiian Chieftain. Your feedback paved the way for the new Sea School Northwest program. You stood beside GHHS to carve out time for winter maintenance.

After the holidays, I started my first day back by signing a big stack of thank you letters. I was so moved to see your names, one after another. This tight-knit community is bringing your talents and resources to care for the Lady Washington and Hawaiian Chieftain as never before. All of the successes this past year rested on your support, and you have held fast through everything 2017 threw at us.

For your review, we've put together the impact numbers from 2017. I hope you will love what you see. For starters, there was a 30% increase in the number of students in our education programs. 41 adults, including the Tongue Point cadets you'll read about in this newsletter, got the experience of a lifetime learning job skills. You allowed a whopping 75,482 people to step aboard in 2017, five thousand more than last year.

In 2017, we spent \$18 for each person served. For every \$1 you donated, we leveraged \$5 in government and private grant dollars. Your year-end donations, totaling over \$40,000, made winter maintenance possible.

When I say Lady Washington and Hawaiian Chieftain are "your ships," I really mean it. Your support in 2017 has made the Historical Seaport better than ever. My heartfelt thanks to you for your remarkable generosity.
